Sites are subject to change based on enrollment, or maintenance work that may need to be done at the school building. Due to floor cleaning at the above summer sites, sites may be relocated for the last few weeks. Information will be given at your summer site once it becomes available.

1. To be eligible for the Kids Network summer program: a child must have been currently enrolled in the Kids Network program through the last day of school for the 2016-2017 school year; **OR** have been offered and accepted a position off of the wait list to start on August 14, 2017 (the first day of school for the 2017-2018 school year). Children **must** have completed kindergarten and not yet have begun sixth grade in order to be eligible. *(There will be no program for pre-K children during summer 2017 due to building availability with regards to our state license.)*
2. In order for current Kids Network families to be enrolled in the summer 2017 program, families must complete a registration form for each child to be registered. Registration for summer 2017 will begin Monday, April 3. Families will be given priority at the summer site assigned for their school so long as registrations are received by Friday, April 7. Registration forms for summer will be turned in to your Kids Network location during the week of summer registration.
3. Summer tuition will be automatically debited from your account through EZ-EFT on the first and third Friday of the month. There are five summer deductions beginning with the first Friday of June and ending with the first Friday of August. Tuition is based on enrollment category, not attendance or the number of days between deduction dates. Fieldtrips, transportation, breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack are included in the contracted amount (see #4).

Part-time Enrollment Category (Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays ONLY)

First Child	\$1080.00	\$216.00
Additional Child	\$1080.00	\$216.00

* There is no additional child rate for the part-time enrollment category.

** Children registered at for the part-time enrollment category may only use services on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Use of alternate days is not permitted regardless of circumstance.

*** Changes in enrollment category is not permitted following 4:00 pm on the last scheduled day of school. Request must be received by the Foundation office prior to this deadline to be honored.

**** Families are charged the full deduction amount scheduled for the chosen enrollment category, regardless of attendance.

*Summer Activity Fee: \$50.00 per child – payment will be automatically deducted from your account on Friday, June 2, 2017 (*Families receiving Title 20 subsidy see #10)*

5. The deduction amount above will be deducted over 5 deductions throughout the summer. The dates for the deductions are as follows:

- Deduction 1- Friday, June 2, 2017
- Deduction 2- Friday, June 16, 2017
- Deduction 3- Friday, July 7, 2017
- Deduction 4- Friday, July 21, 2017
- Deduction 5- Friday, August 4, 2017

6. Registration for the chosen enrollment category is a commitment for the entire summer. If you withdraw your child during summer and do not pay the balance of summer, your child may be withdrawn from the Kids Network program for the upcoming school year, depending on the current status of your home school's wait list. Families may disenroll from the summer program through the last day of school without being charged the entire summer balance. *If you have a court-ordered degree indicating a specific period of custody during the summer months which the child will not require services, you may be eligible to be charged only for the weeks your child attends. This will only apply if the child does not attend the program during the time your child is scheduled to be with their other parent. See your Site Director for further details.*

7. Lunch is provided daily to each child registered in the summer program. There is no additional charge for lunch as it is included in your summer tuition. A lunch menu will be posted at your child's summer site. Children will have the option to bring a sack lunch if they desire.

8. Breakfast and afternoon snacks are provided daily. Please check with your child's summer site each week for a posting of the current week's menu and times that snacks are served.

9. Please check the enclosed summer calendar for a complete listing of your child's summer activities. Specific questions related to the summer calendar can be directed to your Site Director. Parent/guardian volunteers are always welcome to attend field trips. If you are interested in volunteering, please speak with your Site Director. Transportation for field trips is provided by Student Transportation of Nebraska, Inc.

10. Families interested in registering their child/ren for the summer 2017 Kids Network program must complete the registration form for each child to be registered, by the specified deadline. Families will be charged a \$50.00 activity fee per child. Activity fee charges will be deducted from your account in addition to summer tuition charges on Friday, June 2, 2017. The activity fee is non-refundable should you decide to remove from the summer program prior to the first day of the summer program. Children receiving Title 20 child care subsidy benefits are not subject to activity fees as DHHS directly reimburses the Foundation for activity fees.
